The Connecticut Masters' Games is the largest amateur masters' multi sport Olympic-style event in Connecticut. The Connecticut Masters' Games is a 501(c) (3) organization and a member in good standing with the National Senior Games Association. The Connecticut Masters' Games is dedicated to providing a forum that initiates and encourages camaraderie between different ages, socioeconomic and cultural groups through athletic competition and the Olympic Spirit. In 2012, over 1,300+ master athletes from all over New England participated in 15 different sport offerings. Participant's ages vary from 50 to 95 years of age.

The Connecticut Masters' Games is a qualifier for the National Senior Games. Sports currently offered at the National Senior Games are archery, badminton, basketball, bowling, cycling, golf, horseshoes, race walk, racquetball, road race, shuffleboard, softball, swimming, table tennis, tennis, track & field, triathlon and volleyball.
